Please ensure your application has been submitted to Staffordshire County Council Admissions by Wednesday 15th January 2020. If your child is baptised or regularly attends Church don't forget to submit a copy of your child's baptism certificate and supplementary form along with your application.

School Milk Spring 2020

Nursery & Reception Children:

Children under the age of 5 will receive free milk in school. If you wish for your child to continue having milk after they turn 5, please contact the office who will then calculate payment required until the end of the current term.

KS1 & KS2 Children:

If your child would like to have milk in school, it will cost £12.76 per term and should be paid on ParentPav.

Milk is now available to be paid on ParentPay. If your child would like milk for the Autumn Term please make sure the £12.60 is paid by **Monday 6**th **January 2020.**

School Fund
