Well done Ava-Lillie, I am so incredible proud of you.

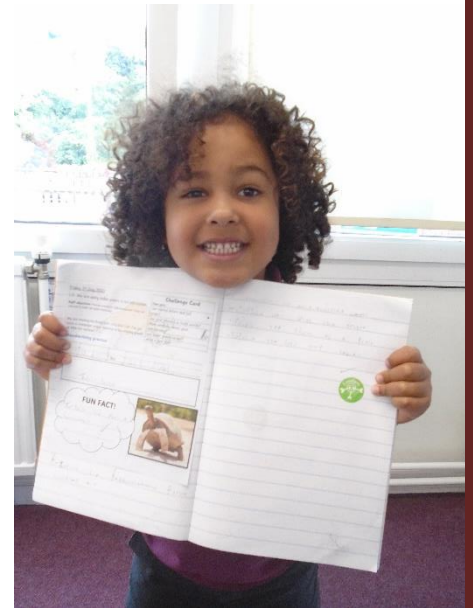

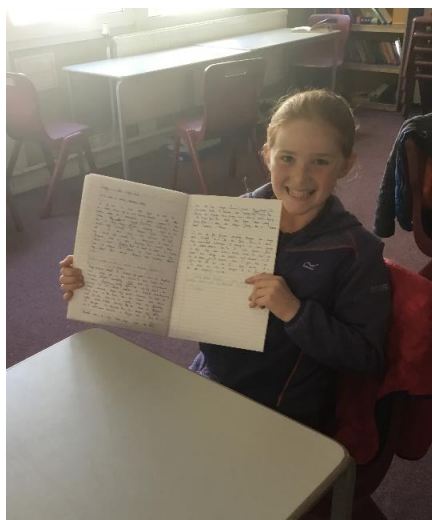
Amber is my star of the week for her effort and motivation towards all of
