We would like to remind parents that dogs are not allowed on the school playground or field at any times. They should remain outside of the school gates.

Kid'z Club

If you would like your child to attend Kid'z Club they will need to be booked in via ParentPay. If you have any problems doing this please contact the school office and we can book your child in for you.

Booking children into Kid'z Club should be done in advance (you are able to book up to a half term at a time). If you book after 3pm the day before your child will not be on the Kid'z Club register.

The charges for Kid'z Club this year are:

Breakfast (7:15am-8:45am) - £5.50

Breakfast (7:30am-8:45am) - £4.50

Club First – £4

Afterschool (3:15pm-4:30pm) - £4

Afterschool (3:15pm-6pm) - £8

If you are late to collect your child from Kid'z Club (after 6pm) you will be charged £16.

If you need to cancel your Kid'z Club booking, this should be done before 3pm the day before otherwise you will still be charged for the session. You can cancel on ParentPay or contact the school office and we can cancel it for you.

School Uniform

We would like to ask parents to make sure school uniform and forest school clothes are named. We are having an increasing number of forest school clothes handed into the office which are not named and we cannot find an owner for.

Forest School

Children in years 1 and 2 should be bringing their forest school kits every Monday for their afternoon lesson.
